The Madison Parish Police Jury met in regular session and convened at the Courthouse Building, Tallulah, Louisiana on Monday, March 9, 2026, 4:00 p.m.

President Sanders called the meeting to order and Vice-President Hughes gave the invocation. The roll call followed the announcement of a quorum. The following members were present at roll call:

A Public Comments Period held at the beginning of the meeting to allow for comments on agenda items received no comments.

President Sanders requested the approval of the Consent Agenda (February 23rd minutes, February Building Report Garbage /Sewer Report and the Outstanding Invoice Report) A motion was made by Mr. Ogden, seconded by Mr. Hicks to approve the consent agenda. No discussion. Motion carried.

The Secretary/Treasurer asked for permission to pay all invoices based on available funds. The President asked for a motion to pay outstanding invoices with available funds or as funds become available. A motion was offered by Mr. Hicks, seconded by Mr. Wilson to pay the outstanding invoices with available funds or as funds become available. No discussion. Motion carried.

A revised Cooperative Endeavor Agreement (CEA) with the Parish and Louisiana Department of Veterans Affairs was presented to the jurors. The operational and maintenance costs was increased from \$1,075.00 to \$1,281.98 to be paid monthly. Mr. Hicks motioned to approved the revised agreement and seconded by Ogden. The motion included giving the president authorization to sign the CEA. No discussion. Motion carried.

At the request of the Registrar of Voters, jurors were asked to reimburse she and her chief deputy \$250.42 each for their portion of their health insurance that they pay to the Secretary of State's office. The jurors agreed to approve the request that was motioned by Mr. Hughes and seconded by Mr. Wilson. At the request of the President a roll call vote was taken and the vote was as follows:

Each juror reported on concerns within their district.

The Superintendent reiterated the immediate need for employees and was advised to hire one employee per position in the interim.

During public comments, Mrs. B. Rogers requested the jury to assist with the annual parish cleanup campaign. Once again, it was suggested that a container be placed in each district. Mr. Hughes offered a motion, seconded by Mr. Ogden. No discussion. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board the meeting was adjourned by a motion from Mr. Hughes.
